



APPLICANTS, PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE

NABET 700 CEP receives a tremendous volume of telephone traffic. Unfortunately, that precludes us from taking as much time with inquiries as everyone would like. **It is therefore essential that all applicants adhere to the following guidelines.**

Applicants for permittee status must complete ***NABETiquette***, a half-day set etiquette and protocol workshop. The workshop is generally offered once a month, so please call our office or visit our website to find out about upcoming dates. Due to the current popularity of the film industry, be advised that vacancies for the course fill up quickly, so come into our office and register in advance!

The fee for the course is \$100.00, and can be paid by cash (exact), credit card or debit. There will be no additional application fee.

Application forms may be picked up at ***NABETiquette***, the NABET office or downloaded from our website. Please note that some departments have more specific qualifications, so please visit the Department Qualifications page or ask about them at ***NABETiquette***.

Applications are accepted during regular business hours at the office. Please have your completed application checked by one of our staff to ensure that it is complete. This will avoid unnecessary processing delays. Completed applications will not be accepted unless a ***NABETiquette*** certificate is attached.

Once your application has been received, it must await the approval of the vice-president of the department to which you are applying. We endeavour to process all applications on at least a monthly basis. Sometimes, however, busy work schedules of our VPs lengthen the procedure. Other times word may come after a few weeks.

TO FREELANCERS APPLYING FOR PERMITTEE STATUS WITH NABET 700 CEP...

Before making an application to join **NABET 700 CEP**, we are ensuring that you have been informed and are fully aware of your primary obligations as a member.

Articles 2.1 and 2.2 of the **NABET 700 CEP** By-Laws stipulate that...

“The purpose of the local is to regulate in Canada sound labour relations between employees and employers in the film industry, commercial productions, stage productions and all other allied or associated industry (except where CEP locals currently exist representing membership in these respective industries).

To bargain collectively for, to enter into and carry out and administer collective agreements and other related undertakings and agreements containing provisions as to rates of pay, hours of work and other terms and conditions of employment of labour and on behalf of its members to negotiate the adjustment of, or otherwise resolve, disputes arising out of the interpretation, application, and/or administration of such agreements”.
