1. Photocopy of your current valid Ontario hairdressing license
2. Items on the basic hair list kit
3. Minimum of five licensed years of practicing hairdressing – preference to one year or more (minimum of 40 days in film) experience with a professional film, theatre or television production company in the hair department to have been done in the past seven years
4. All correspondence in writing with the department in that industry
5. Application to be signed by a member in good standing of the hair department
6. Two letters of reference from licensed hairdressers specifically stating why they find you to be suitable to that department in that industry
7. Resume which clearly states previous job duties, exact days worked, name of supervisor and contact numbers
