This 3-hour interactive seminar will cover the basics of Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG), designed to provide workers with the essential information that will enable them to protect themselves and others from hazardous spills during the transport of dangerous substances.

The course is sector specific. It will include a review of the dangerous goods classifications, packaging, labels, placarding and documentation.

Participants will also examine the laws (TDG Act) and regulations that apply to the carriage of dangerous goods. Technicians will be made aware of the responsibilities that become the driver's when dangerous goods are on board.

After successful completion of the course and written examination, each participant receives a wallet card and wall certificate.

The instructor for this course is a certified trainer with FSN Training & Development.

Participants will receive a TDG Handbook, issued by FSN.
